You can appeal the award on a question of law within a set time period, or now in terms of the latest Case Law from the Gauteng High Court, you can also take the matter on review.

Under the old Sectional Titles Act 95 of 1986, Management Rule 71 (now obsolete), you were not entitled to take an arbitration award on appeal. You were only allowed to take it on review.
