1. KEY ITEMS OF THE PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT:

- 1.1 "From midnight on Thursday 26 March until midnight on Thursday 16 April, <u>all South</u> Africans will have to stay at home.
- 1.2 The categories of people who will be exempted from this lockdown are the following: health workers in the public and private sectors, emergency personnel, those in security services such as the police, traffic officers, military medical personnel, soldiers and other persons necessary for our response to the pandemic.
- 1.3 <u>Individuals will not be allowed to leave their homes except under strictly controlled circumstances</u>, such as to seek medical care, buy food, medicine and other supplies or collect a social grant.
- 1.3 All shops and businesses will be closed, except for pharmacies, laboratories, banks, essential financial and payment services, including the JSE, supermarkets, petrol stations and health care providers".
